UTAH/ARIZONA ROAD TRIP ITINERARY

ARIZONA-UTAH-COLORADO

This is the itinerary for the 10day road trip that my friends and I took starting in Arizona, heading through southern Utah and then finishing in Colorado. We went September 17-27 and the weather was perfect during that time of year. It was pretty much mid 80's to 90's during the day in Arizona and Utah, and it cooled down into the high 50's at night. It was a little bit colder in Colorado, somewhere between 60 and 70 depending on the time of day.

PHOENIX/SCOTTSDALE

- 6:15PM Arrive in Phoenix
- 7:00PM Dinner @ Kelly's in Scottsdale

Notes: I have a friend who lives in Phoenix, so we stayed at her house on Friday night.

LAKE POWELL (PAGE, AZ)

• 12:00PM - Pick up Rental Car @ Hertz

- 12:30PM Drive from Phoenix, AZ to Page, AZ (4hr 20min)
- **5:30PM** <u>Horseshoe Bend</u> to watch sunset
- 8:00PM Dinner @ El Tapatio

Notes: We grabbed a quick lunch en route to Page and stayed at a simple <u>Airbnb</u>. There was a \$10 entry fee to get into Horseshoe Bend.

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LAKE POWELL (PAGE, AZ)

- 7:00AM Grocery store run
- **9:00AM** Pick up kayaks @ <u>Antelope Point Marina Rentals</u> and Kayaked to Antelope Canyon (1hr 40min one-way)

SUN

- 11:00AM Hike Antelope Canyon
- 1:00PM Kayak back to marina
- 3:00PM Wakesurf & Boat Ride
- 9:00PM Dinner @ Jádí To´ho Restaurant (on the marina)

Notes: We did a grocery store run to get snacks and things for sandwiches for the days we were hiking. The kayak rentals were \$45 per person. You can kayak to Antelope Canyon and then hike through it (the entrance to the canyon from land was closed due to COVID). We had a friend who had a boat, but I highly recommend renting one if you don't have access to one at Lake Powell. We surfed and did a cruise through the canyon. The rentals go fast so it is definitely something to plan ahead of time. There was a \$30 fee to get into Antelope Point Marina.

ZION NATIONAL PARK

- 10:00AM Drive to Zion (2hr 20min)
- 12:30PM Check-in @ Hampton Inn Springdale
- 1:00PM Hike Canyon Overlook Trail (1 mile roundtrip)
- 3:00PM Shuttle to Angel's Landing Trailhead
- 3:30PM Hike Angel's Landing (5 miles roundtrip)
- 7:00PM Dinner @ Zion Pizza & Noodle Co.

Notes: We had hotel points, so we used a lot of those for this trip, but there are a ton of cute Airbnb's in the Zion area as well. You have to buy shuttle tickets the day before you need them to get on the shuttle to certain hikes like Angel's Landing. We missed the shuttle ticket the first day so ended up going to the free "first come first serve" shuttle at 3PM and it worked out great. You can drive to the Canyon Overlook Trail and it was an awesome view. There is a \$30 entry fee for Zion that is valid for 7 days.

- 8:30AM Pick up water shoe rentals @ Zion Outfitter (\$25)
- 9:00AM Shuttle to The Narrows Trailhead
- 9:30AM Hike The Narrows (about 11 miles roundtrip)
- 7:30PM Dinner @ Bit & Spur

Notes: It was a little chilly hiking through The Narrows and there were spots where you had to swim. The water shoes and walking sticks were LIFE SAVERS. This was one of our favorite hikes and Bit & Spur was super cute and yummy.
